NARRATOR: The prince of batsman in action. Don Bradman, just come to Mansa state, and already known as the most phenomenal run-getting machine the world has ever seen. A favourite shot of Don's is the pull. Watch how his right foot travels across the wicket, so that he can get [batting cricket ball] behind the ball as he plots it to the pickets. Bradman used this stroke to get the necessary four out in making the highest score for Test cricket at Leeds, last year, when he made 334.

DON BRADMAN: No, I never started out to break any records. I've always tried to do the best I can for the team that I'm playing for.
