

Listening and colouring game | Year 1

There must be a minimum of two players.

Materials needed:

Coloured pencils – red, blue, yellow, green, pink, orange, purple.

Step 1

Print the two landscape images out and hand to participants.

Step 2

Nominate a person to read the colour list out loud. You can have more than one reader for a larger group, with participants taking turns to read the list.

As the colour list is read to the participant/s they must follow the instructions.

Colour List:

1. Colour the fire red.
2. Colour the river blue.
3. Colour the stars in the night sky pink.
4. Write how many stars are in the night sky.
5. Colour the sun in the daytime sky yellow.
6. Colour the moon in the night sky purple.
7. Colour the dingo orange.
8. Draw a rock for the dingo to stand on.
9. Colour the grass green.
10. Write your name in the sun.

Step 3

When everyone is finished, check the pages together.

- Did everyone get the colour list correct?
- What was different about the pages in your group?

Step 4

Ask each person if they discovered they were a good reader or listener.

Did they speak clearly or did they follow instructions well?

Step 5

After playing this game with the provided landscape images and colour list, ask participants to draw their own night-time and daytime landscape.

Can they make a colour list and play with their classmates?
