<p><b>Action move around</b></p> <p>This action can be done in single formation with limited room in a classroom.</p>	<p><b>Action move around</b></p> <p>This action can be done both as a group (plane formation) and in single formation.</p>
<p><b>Single formation</b></p> <p>Break away from your group and move around the classroom as if you were flying. Pick an object you can see from the sky and remember it as you will need to tell your group when you sit back down.</p>	<p><b>Single formation</b></p> <p>Break away from your group and move around the space as if you were flying. 	<p><b>Plane formation</b></p> <p>Move around the space as a group in your plane. Look out your window and pick an object you can see from the sky. Remember the object as you will need to tell your group when you sit back down.</p>
<p><b>Step 5</b></p> <p>Do a practice round first so that all players understand the actions.
